

During June, some slightly better news from both the Eurozone and the US economy allowed global markets to rally. The fund rose +2.9% versus +5.7% for the IMA UK Equity Income sector over the month, giving back some of the relative gains made in May.

In a very quiet month for fundamental newsflow, the most positive contributors to return were Sage, Unilever and Pearson. The most negative were Procter & Gamble, Euromoney and MITIE. Procter's poor stock performance was due to a third cut in management guidance this year (this time from +4-5% organic sales growth to+2-3% growth for the fourth quarter - disappointing, but not a disaster). Taking a longer-term view, we have seen recent pessimism towards P & G as an opportunity to accumulate one of the best brand portfolios in the world on a starting dividend yield just shy of 4%. Having initiated a holding in the first quarter, P & G is now the fund's third largest position.

More generally, Evenlode's combination of quality and value continues to reassure me, and should prepare it well for an unpredictable future.
