

The UK market fell slightly in March as worries over both economic recovery and the Eurozone crisis re-asserted themselves at the end of the month. The fund rose +0.6%, with positive contributors including Diploma (who released a positive trading statement), Petrofac and Coca Cola. Negative contributors included Sage, WS Atkins and Pearson.

We made some changes to the portfolio, including the sale of long-standing holding Domino Printing at the start of the month due to valuation concerns. Elsewhere we've reduced exposure to several other stocks where recent gains have left forward cash returns looking less attractive. On the buy side we initiated two new positions - Procter & Gamble and Jardine Lloyd Thompson. Both have a history of generating consistently high and stable returns on invested capital, but both have underperformed the market this year as more 'exciting' stocks have led the market higher. We've also rebuilt our holdings in Glaxosmithkline and Pearson. In general (though not exclusively), we are currently seeing best value in the more stable business models in our investable universe.
