

Market sentiment continues to benefit from central bank efforts around the world to keep monetary policy very easy. The highlight in September was the Federal Reserve's announcement of a third round of quantitative easing, open-ended in scope and scheduled to continue until there is a 'significant' improvement in the US employment market. These actions, in my view, further increase the long-term risk of higher inflation.

The fund rose +1.2% over the month compared with a rise of +1.6% for the IMA UK Equity Income Sector. The strongest contributors to return were Sage, WS Atkins and Halfords. The only significant news from these holdings was a reassuring trading statement from WS Atkins, with particularly encouraging prospects in their energy business. The main negative contributors to fund performance were Imperial Tobacco and Microsoft. Imperial was impacted by several pieces of regulatory newsflow, while Microsoft announced a +15% dividend increase. It's a move in the right direction, but with free cash-flow cover at 4x and \$50bn of net cash on Microsoft's balance sheet, we'd have liked to see a bigger uplift.

Although economic uncertainty continues, businesses are still grinding out incremental progress and the portfolio's combination of quality and value remains high.
