
MANAGER COMMENTARY

June saw little fundamental company news, so the main focus for investors were macro developments, including the surprise UK election result, global economic data and central banker communiques. Though economic (and inflationary) leading indicators remain muted, interest rate expectations rose in June as several central banks (including the European Central Bank and Bank of England) noted their directional desire to withdraw stimulus. This contributed to a rise in government bond yields and weaker global stock markets, trends that have continued into early July.

Evenlode fell -2.1% in June compared to a fall of -2.5% for the UK market and -2.4% for the IA UK All Companies Sector. The most negative contributors to return were Unilever, Sage and Burberry. Unilever and Burberry shares fell back on no specific news, whilst Sage announced the disposal of its North American payments business. Though the disposal price was somewhat below expectations, we think this move makes sense. More generally, we remain encouraged by Sage's strategic progress, new product development and high free cash flow generation. The most positive contributors to performance were Johnson and Johnson, Jardine Lloyd Thomson and Pagegroup. J & J announced positive pipeline updates and the completion of its Actelion acquisition. JLT and Pagegroup shares rose on no specific news.

Towards the end of June, WS Atkins' shareholders approved the recommended takeover offer from SNC-Lavalin, and this transaction will now complete in July. Other than this, there were no significant changes to the fund and we continue to see a good balance of quality, resilience and dividend appeal in the aggregate portfolio.




