### MANAGER COMMENTARY


After a positive start to the year, markets gave back some of their gains in March. The rapidity of interest rate rises over recent months have steadily unveiled some lurking fragilities in certain corners of global financial markets and the latest manifestation is a banking crisis. Originating in the US with a run on Silicon Valley Bank, worries spread as investors turned their eye to other weak banks, both in the US and further afield, culminating in an emergency weekend-takeover of Credit Suisse by UBS. Though the overall banking sector looks in considerably better health than it did during the 2008-9 crisis, worries remain that other weaker banks could potentially fail over coming weeks or months. Investors are also now concerned that the aftershocks from these events may have broader consequences for the real economy, as banks rein in their horns. On the flipside, these developments may, at the margin, ease global inflationary pressures - which provides a silver-lining for investors to consider. From a performance perspective, downside risk moved back into focus, with the share prices of financial companies (and more generally companies with high financial and economic leverage) leading global stock markets lower.

During March, Evenlode Income rose +1.5% compared to a fall of -2.8% for the FTSE All-Share and -3.4% for the IA UK All Companies sector. The market leadership, healthy bedrock of repeat-purchase cash generation, strong balance sheets and lack of exposure to banks within the Evenlode Income portfolio all helped relative performance.

In terms of individual stocks, the strongest contributors to Evenlode Income's performance were Reckitt Benckiser, RELX and Microsoft. Reckitt Benckiser reported encouraging full year 2022 results showing strong sales and profit growth. RELX's share price increased on no specific news. Microsoft announced plans to incorporate OpenAI's machine learning technology into its Microsoft 365 suite of software. The most negative contributors were Ashmore, Experian and Victrex. The share prices of Ashmore and Victrex decreased on no specific news. Experian's share price decrease was linked to the banking crisis which could potentially impact credit availability. We added to the fund's position during the month as it is a resilient business, which continued to grow revenue during previous banking crises, including the Great Financial Crisis in 2009, and has strong medium-term growth prospects.

Looking ahead, the outlook is no less uncertain than normal. But we remain encouraged by the resilience and growth opportunities that we see across the portfolio. Valuations also remain modest, with the fund's 2.7% historic dividend yield well covered by a free cash flow yield of more than 5%.




