

MANAGER COMMENTARY

July sees in the half year corporate reporting season, and at the time of writing (3 August) 58% of the portfolio by weight has provided an update on trading in the first six months of the year. Operating results have been positive overall with revenues, operating margins and, importantly, cash flows improving. The return of cash flow is particularly encouraging given the challenges of input cost inflation and supply chain disruption seen in recent times, although the picture continues to be volatile. Some companies such as consumer goods giants L'Oréal and Nestlé experienced greatly improved operating cash flow as they used up the inventories that they had purchased last year. Conversely, some others such as luxury market leader LVMH invested further in inventories to support the strong growth that they are experiencing. Yet others are experiencing different effects from the pandemic; laboratory operator Quest Diagnostics and diagnostic equipment maker Siemens Healthineers are seeing covid testing-related revenues and cash flows decline as expected.

The market reaction has been muted to these results overall and the fund rose slightly against a strong market during the month which was driven by financial services, media and energy companies. Financial companies are rebounding from weakness earlier in the year, whilst sentiment towards energy companies is aided by a rising oil price. The fund has limited exposure to these two sectors, and recent performance has perhaps been to do with the near-term outlook. Whilst most companies are suggesting continued sales growth and improving margins into the second half of the year, there is a clear message that things are likely to slow. This may be one of the reasons why new holding Diageo's share price has lagged, presenting an attractive entry point. The global market leader in spirits, the company has seen slowing demand for its products in the US.




ANNUAL DIVIDEND PAYMENTS
