## Evenlode Global Income Feeder Fund (“the Fund”)

This is a sub fund of Evenlode ICAV, an Irish collective asset management vehicle.

Treasury Capital Fund Solutions Limited is the manager of the ICAV.

### Objectives and investment policy

The Fund is a feeder fund which will invest at least 85% of its assets in TB Evenlode Global Income (the “Master Fund”), which aims to provide long-term total returns, with an emphasis on income. The Fund will, therefore, be a holder of shares in the Master Fund.

The Master Fund invests predominantly in the shares of global listed companies. It aims to invest in a focused portfolio of shares offering a combination of high and growing cash flows (to deliver both capital growth and dividend growth for the Master Fund) and low business risk.

The Fund may hold up to 15% of its assets in cash and similar liquid assets and also in financial derivative investments which may be used only for hedging purposes. Derivatives are linked to the rise and fall of other assets. They can generate returns when share prices and/or indices fall.

The Fund’s investment returns are expected to be similar to those of the Master Fund but may differ as a result of its holdings in cash or other similar investments, movements in currency exchange rates and fund charges.

Any income this share class generates will be paid out to you.

You can buy and sell shares on any business day in Dublin and London.

Recommendation: this Fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 5 years.

The Master Fund is a sub-fund of TB Evenlode Investment Funds ICVC, an open-ended investment company incorporated with limited liability and registered in England and Wales and authorised by the Financial Conduct Authority as a UCITS.
