MANAGER COMMENTARY

December was another volatile month. The FTSE-100 index ended down 1.29%, after being down 7.0% briefly in mid-month. TB Wise Income ended the month 0.6% lower, compared to a loss of 0.4% for the IA Flexible sector average. The fund's underperformance of the sector average is due to our lack of holdings in the US, where yields are low and asset prices look rather high.

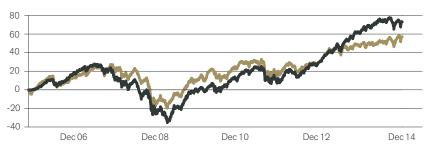
For 2014 overall, the fund made a total return of 4.7%, comprised of the yield and a small capital loss. Wise Income's volatility continues to be much lower than that of the stock market.

Cash in the fund had been raised to 10%, which was helpful during the sell-off. Market weakness allowed us to add to holdings selectively, while retaining a higher than usual level of cash, currently 6.4%, as it is not yet clear that the period of volatility has ended.

Investors remain focussed on macro themes, and see falling oil prices as worryingly indicative of a lack of growth, rather than as a welcome stimulus for consumers. While aware of the macro themes, we continue to look for value across our investable universe. On the whole, we are seeing more value in shares, less in commercial property than there was, and much less in fixed interest. The fund's asset allocation reflects these views.

Wise Income's income yield is 5.1%, as at January 8th. The fund owns some significantly undervalued assets, and we hope to see at least some of that value realised in the year ahead.
